The pilot program was highly successful, with enthusiastic feedback from both the participants and their mentors. There are clear benefits to the participants, you, as an employer and to Wayne County as a whole.

Please review the materials and consider nominating an individual from your organization. You can be assured that the experience will be positive for anyone who is interested in learning more about our community and developing their personal and professional skills. In addition to nominating a participant (mentee) for the program, we are also seeking program mentors who can share their professional experiences and commit to 4-5 hours per month over the duration of the program working one-on-one with one of the mentees.
